With due respect , I on behalf of Indian Veterinary Association would like to lay before you the following few lines for favour of your kind perusal and needful action.

That Sir, as you are aware that our Hon'ble Prime Minister has already launched the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP), a 100% funding from the Central Government with Rs. 12,652 Crores for a period of five years till 2024 with a aim to control Foot and Mouth Disease(FMD) and Brucellosis by 2025 and eradicate by 2030 .

That Sir, the National Livestock Mission (NLM) is also going on in the Country including Assam.

That Sir, the present Cadres strength scenario of State Veterinary Department are as follows.

That Sir, all most all the top level technical official posts are vacant since long, which hampering the implementation of Central as well State Govt. programmes in a smooth manner.

That Sir, in the last 2 years there is no promotion from VO/BVO cadre to SDVO level cadre postinspite of having nearly 94 resultant vacancy in the department, where as VO/BVO has already completed more than 32 (Thirty Two) yearscontinuous service in the same initial Cadre/entry cadre post , which jeopardize the moral of Veterinary Officers.

Therefore , I would like to request your honour kindly to use your good office for early fill up all the promotional vacant post so as to boost up the moral of deprive officers of the veterinary department in your state and thereby encourage them for implementation of all the National programmes of NADCP/ NLM etc. including all the developmental activities in letter & spirit and thereby all the dreams of Hon'ble Prime Minister will be fulfilled .
